3. This scholarship is solely for registration fees and does not pay for equipment, hotel, food or travel expenses.
4. Applicant must participate in the main fundraiser for that year.

I understand that any financial assistance is granted through a committee process and the Program Director is not responsible for the decisions of the committee. YANKTON AREA ICE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

YAIA has created a scholarship program to youth hockey players and youth figure skaters to assist with registration fees.

Each scholarship recipient will be required to pay the USA Hockey \$30 registration fee and/or the US Figure Skater \$10.00 registration fee to YAIA. Arrangements can be made with YAIA to pay these fees in a timely manner. A minimum of 25 total volunteer hours is required per player/skater to offset scholarship costs. These hours consist of the mandatory 15 hours per player/skater and for the scholarship recipient's additional 10 hours for the total of 25 hours per player/skater. Scholarship funds are solely for registration fees and NOT to pay for equipment, hotel, food or travel expenses. Each scholarship recipient will be required to participate in the main fundraiser for that year. YAIA scholarships are awarded seasonally and a new one will need to be submitted and reviewed for each season the player/skater participates. The scholarship will be available to any member in good standing within the Yankton Area Ice Association. The legal guardian of player/skater will submit the application in order for a player/skater to be considered for a scholarship.

The YAIA Board of Directors will consider each scholarship at the regularly scheduled board meeting closest to the date of submission. The Board meets at a minimum once a month. Minutes of the Board's decisions will be recorded within the meeting and maintained by the Secretary.

A response letter will be sent to each applicant outlining the Board's decision regarding the request for scholarship.
